**Tuition Payment Options**

**All families are required to enroll with FACTS and choose a payment method and plan.** Payment plans available through FACTS include:

- 1. 1 PAYMENT PLAN – FACTS Payment Plan Enrollment Fee Waived**  
The entire amount of the tuition billing is due on or before June 1, 2026. A discount of \$50.00 is given per family (not per student) for this option. Lump sum payment received after June 1, 2026, or accounts that receive financial assistance from the school, will not be eligible for the \$50.00 discount.
- 2. 2 PAYMENTS – FACTS Payment Plan Enrollment Fee Waived**  
June 2026 and January 2027
- 3. 4 PAYMENTS – FACTS Payment Plan Enrollment Fee: \$55**  
June, September, Dec 2026 and March 2027
- 4. 10 PAYMENTS – FACTS Payment Plan Enrollment Fee: \$55**  
June 2026 - March 2027
- 5. 12 PAYMENTS – FACTS Payment Plan Enrollment Fee: \$55**  
April 2026 – March 2027

**Enrollment Fee Options**

**ENROLLMENT FEE**

The enrollment fee will automatically be applied to your FACTS account. If you know that your student will not be returning to GR for the 2026-2027 school year, please submit a written notice of withdrawal to the administrative office no later than March 1.

**BUS FEE**

Annual Bus Fee (One Student):	\$1,000 both ways or \$750 one way
Annual Bus Fee (Family):	\$1,500 both ways or \$1,000 one way

### **CHROMEBOOK**

New students must purchase a Chromebook from Gabriel Richard. Chromebooks or other devices not issued to the respective student by Gabriel Richard are not allowed. Fee includes cost of Chromebook, accidental damage insurance and network maintenance for all four years. This fee is non-refundable once Chromebook is issued. Fee must be paid in full before student receives his/her Chromebook.

**FEE: \$450**

### **COURSE**

This includes all AP test fees, as well as various class fees that include, but are not limited to, biology, physics, chemistry, clay works, and acrylic painting. See Course Curriculum Guide for all class/AP test fees.

### **GRADUATION**

Graduation fee covers the students cap, gown, tassel, diploma cover, diploma, and any department academic awards.

**FEE: \$100**

### **PARKING**

Students who drive their cars to school and park in the school lot must register their cars and purchase a parking permit. The permit fee helps to partially defray the cost of snow removal and minor parking lot repairs. Every family car that will be driven must be registered when obtaining the permit. If a different car is driven or added during the year, that car must be registered at the office.

Seniors who wish to paint their parking spot will incur an additional fee of \$40. The additional \$40 covers the cost that the school must pay at the end of each school year to repaint the parking spaces black; it does not cover the cost of paint and supplies for students to paint their spaces

**FEE: \$50 per permit (\$40 additional for seniors to paint their spot)**

### **CLASS CHANGE**

Class changes must be approved by the school principal. A class change fee will be charged for student/family-initiated changes. No class change fee will be charged for faculty-initiated changes.

**FEE: \$50 plus course fee (if required)**

### **LATE FEE**

A \$25 late fee will be charged to all families who have not paid their accounts by the due date. A \$25 fee will be added to all accounts returned from FACTS prior to completion of the arranged payment schedule.

**FEE: \$25**

### **RETURNED CHECK**

A fee of \$35 will be charged on all checks returned from bank as uncollectible.

**FEE: \$35**

## **ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION FEE (PAY TO PLAY)**

A participation fee is assessed per family, per season as follows:

- \$225 First sport season of participation
- \$175 Second sport season of participation
- \$100 Third sport season of participation

Pay-to-Pay family participation fees are due as follows:

- Fall season participation fee is due September 1
- Winter season participation fee is due December 1
- Spring season participation fee is due April 1

This fee will not apply to hockey which is a self-funding organization.

### **FEE: Varies, where applicable**

\*Note: A uniform replacement fee of \$240 will be applied for any student who does not return his/her full uniform at the end of the season.

## **VOLUNTEER FEES / REQUIREMENTS**

20 mandatory volunteer hours are required per family per school year. These hours must consist of a minimum of the following:

- One (1) hour toward a Parent Group meeting or activity
- Eight (8) hours toward Advancement activities (e.g., fundraisers)
- Eleven (11) hours toward helping at athletic events or general school/club activities including robotics, theater, Open House, or other opportunities listed on Volunteer Hub.

### **Families who have students grades 9-11 only:**

Hours must be completed between June 1, 2026 and May 31, 2027. A \$750 fee will be applied to FACTS on June 1 to any family with students in grades 9-11 who does not fulfill these requirements.

### **Families who have a student in grade 12:**

Hours must be completed between June 1, 2026 and April 30, 2027. A \$750 fee will be assessed on May 1 to any family with a student in grade 12 who does not fulfill these requirements.

The hours will be tracked using Volunteer Hub, which can be found on the school website ([gabrielrichard.volunteerhub.com](http://gabrielrichard.volunteerhub.com)). If any of the required volunteer hours are not fully met, the full \$750 fee will be added to your FACTS account. The fee will not be adjusted or prorated for any volunteer hours that are completed short of the full requirement; you must serve all hours or you will be charged. You may elect to pay the \$750 to opt out of the requirement.

### **RAFFLE TICKETS**

In an ongoing effort to make Gabriel Richard Catholic High School more affordable, each family will be required to sell \$500 in raffle tickets each year. Tickets and information regarding the sale of the tickets will be distributed at the beginning of the school year in September.

### **SEATING OF STUDENTS**

No student will be seated at the beginning of the semester in question unless all tuition and fee payments are satisfied with the Business Office. Students who owe tuition, fees, or other financial obligations at the time of semester exams, will not be allowed to take exams until all obligations have been paid. The school reserves the right to withhold caps and gowns, a student's report card, student/parent access to FACTS SIS, or transcripts, etc.; as well as participation in school activities including athletics and prom, for any families with an outstanding balance. This point is especially important for students transferring out of the school or seniors who wish to have their transcripts issued to colleges.

### **REFUND OF TUITION AND FEES**

**TUITION:** If a student withdraws from Gabriel Richard Catholic High School after registration, the parent must state so in a letter addressed to the principal. Any refunds/charges will be in accordance with the terms as set forth in the Tuition/Fee Contract. There will be a \$300 withdrawal fee if the student withdraws after the first day of class.

**FEES:** Course fees or other associated charges are **non-refundable**. These include registration, bus, graduation, pay-to-play, and parking fees. Books are not refundable.

### **APPEALS AND EXCEPTIONS**

Final interpretation of this Financial Policy shall rest with the Principal of Gabriel Richard Catholic High School.
